Important Info: Please enter before closing date! **Ribbons:** To 8th place. **Class Fees:** Youth under 18 -\$20 per class, adult \$25 per class. Classes combined or split as entries warrant. Riders are encouraged to enter multiple classes to broaden their show experience. **Times:** When schedule is complete, it will be on website www.southwindstables.com Times will NOT be given over the phone. **Food:** good food will be available on grounds. **Facilities:** Show will be held in indoor sand ring. Large ring if weather permits; most classes usually held in small ring. Large Ring is about 10 feet short. Outdoor small grass ring if needed. Outdoor open grassy areas to warm up. Sorry, no stalls available. Please keep all show horses out of barn. Please leave dogs at home. Non-Compete horses welcome; must pay \$30 fee, and sign all release forms. No horses on property without entry and release form. **Attire: Mandatory Helmet!** Safe riding shoes with a heel; shirt with a collar. Neat appearance.

Due to COVID, things will be different from previous years. Anyone on property will be expected to wear a mask when within 20 ft of another person. Please bring as few people as possible. Mounted riders do not need to wear a mask but should keep apart. Please bring your own hand sanitizer. Mask required to come to office. Social distancing is expected. If asked by a volunteer to put on mask or distance, compliance is expected. If you cannot comply with this please stay home.
